## **Ministry Description**

### **Church Mission Mobilizer**

#### **Position Description:**

- To serve as a catalyst for the full mobilization of our church so that we are globally engaged in world missions through The Christian and Missionary Alliance.

#### **Position Amenability:**

- The Church Mission Mobilizer is amenable to the Church Governing Board [or Elders] through the Pastor. He/she is nominated by the Pastor and appointed by the Governing Board to serve for an unspecified term [or for a term as specified in the church bylaws].

#### **Position Responsibilities:**

- Build the mission mobilization team and work closely with them to accomplish the following in our church:
  - Educate and inspire the congregation toward global mission engagement including regular dissemination of information and the implementation of new ideas that will enlarge the mission vision of our church.
  - Stimulate intercessory prayer for world evangelization, Alliance global missions, and Alliance international workers.
  - Challenge our church to growing participation in the Great Commission Fund so that we exceed the goal of 5% of church giving going to Alliance missions.
  - Build a growing understanding of Alliance global missions through regular printed materials

- Plan and coordinate year-round global mission emphases and events.
  - Provide mission resources (books, DVDs, etc.) for all ages in the congregation.
  - Explore and implement plans for cross-cultural service experiences and overseas short-term trips.
  - Mentor those who are called to global mission service from our church.
  - Evaluate, at least annually, the progress being made in the enlargement of global mission engagement in our church.

- Coordinate with Great Commission Women and the District Mission Mobilizer to ensure support and pastoral care for our District international workers, particularly those associated with our church.
  - Work closely with the District Mission Mobilizer as a key resource to the development of our global mission engagement and to ensure our participation in regional or District-wide training events, mission trips, or other District emphases.
